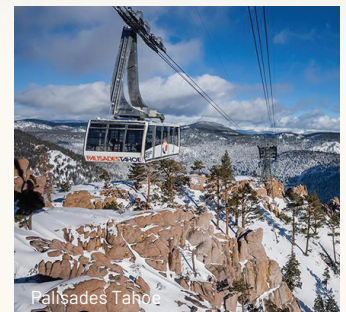

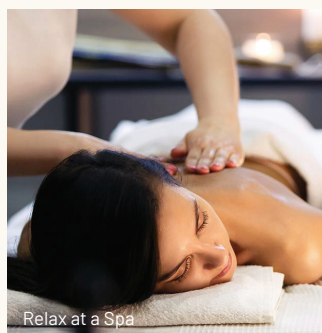

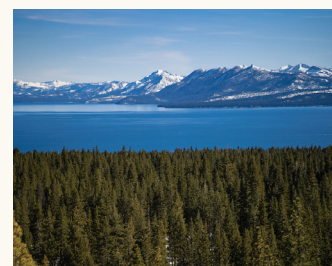
Be Safe and Smart

Road Conditions and Links

When getting around on mountain roads, stay aware of road conditions and plan to be flexible. For the most current information on road conditions, chain requirements, and road closures, visit NVroads.com and roads.dot.ca.gov.

Parking

Parking on the road is prohibited in most areas for snow removal. Check for "No Parking" signs for your safety and to avoid tickets.
