Tahoe Summer Events

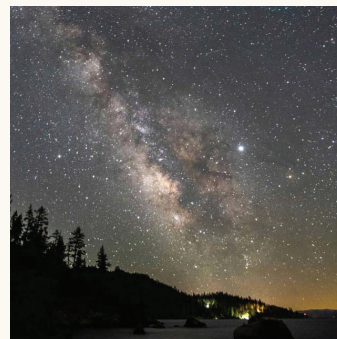
